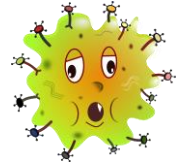


FLU SEASON 2020



WE ARE NOW TAKING BOOKINGS FOR OUR FLU CLINICS; PLEASE RING THE SURGERY TO BOOK AN APPOINTMENT IF YOU FALL INTO ONE OF THE ELIGIBLE CRITERIAS BELOW:

- Aged 65 and over (inc turning 65 before 32/03/2021)
- Aged 6m to 64 years & have a serious medical condition (check criteria with reception)
- Pregnant women
- Patients in long stay residential/ nursing home
- If you are the main carer for an elderly or disabled person
- Patients with a BMI greater than 40
- Children aged 2 & 3 years old (on 31st August 2020) – please ask reception about these clinics

FLU CLINICS MIGHT SEEM A LITTLE DIFFERENT THIS YEAR, PLEASE READ THE INFO BELOW:

- You will be given an allocated time of appointment and the name of the clinician who will be vaccinating – it is important you remember these details for when you arrive on the day
- Do not arrive early for your appointment
- Do not wear multiple layers of clothing
- Wear a face covering/face mask
- Remember! This appointment is for vaccination only.
- To enable us to vaccinate our eligible population in a timely manner whilst adhering to social distancing rules, our staff will not be able to deal with any other enquiries on the day
- For patient safety the car park will remain closed to all vehicles (Saturday clinics)
- Patients will be met at the surgery gate and signposted to their allocated vaccinator (Sat clinics only)
- Do not attend your appointment if you become unwell with any COVID related symptoms or have been in contact with anyone who has recently tested positive
